Additional Services/Fees Policy

updated Jan 6, 2026

Our additional services/fees clearly define the cost for services that can be requested, attended, incurred, or completed that are not included in the original DZ Course. Additional services/fees are subject to HST. Additional services/fees are not subject to Ancillary Fees.

Extra Training- By the hour- Custom Booked

\$120/hr.

Any student at any time can request additional training outside of the DZ Licence course as one-on-one instruction. Additional training may be booked as a "catch up", for better understanding, extra experience or to work on areas that need improvement. Extra training can be attended any time after the classroom session up to the road-testing date (before in-truck lesson one, between in-truck lesson one and two or after second in-truck lesson). **There is a 2-hour minimum on extra training.**

Extra In-Truck Training Half Day- 4.5 hours

For students wishing to take extra hands-on training. You get two in-truck lessons with your course. If you wish to add a third in-truck training day, this would be an extra day of regular in-truck training. Cost is per person for the lesson. Like regular in-truck training, there will be 1 other student with you during this session. This day can be taken any time based on availability.

One on One In-Truck Lesson- Surcharge

\$149

Students may opt out of a group session of in-truck training (offered in course), in lieu they will get a one-on-one lesson for 3 hours. This surcharge will apply.
